Set up an accredited multi sectoral national laboratory;  
 Obtain ISO certification for other existing laboratories (livestock, consumption, ...);  
 Provide support for veterinary diagnostic laboratory in establishing quality assurance system for purposes of accreditation;  
 Help with collection of samples needed for tests;  
 Provide laboratory with aid fund to cover cost of taking samples from livestock;  
 Change legal or regulatory framework;  
 Ensure systematic use of ICTs;  
 Recruit additional human resources;  
 Carry out training and capacity building for specialist staff (training of employees in specialist schools for biology, chemistry, physics, etc.);
