NOTIFICATION OF CATEGORY COMMITMENTS UNDER THE AGREEMENT ON TRADE FACILITATION

COMMUNICATION FROM JAMAICA

Addendum

The following communication, dated 21 August 2019, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Jamaica for Members' information.

Following up from the notification dated 16 August 2018 (G/TFA/N/JAM/1/Add.1), Jamaica hereby makes the following notifications:

(1) Shifting of categories; (2) shifting of categories with extension of definitive implementation dates; (3) definitive implementation dates for categories B and C designations; and (4) designation of additional category A commitments.

1. Jamaica hereby notifies, pursuant to Article 19.1 of the Agreement on Trade Facilitation, that the following provisions have been shifted between categories.
