Promote the facilitation of legitimate trade.

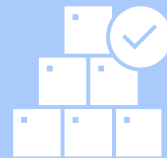


Strengthen the security of the international supply chain.



Existing legislation

Non-discriminatory, allows MRA negotiation, allows integration into OGA, defined procedures, included control system.

Benefits and facilities such as reduced customs controls, priority in cargo release, choice of location for control/clearance, personalized assistance, periodic training.

Highly qualified Customs Service personnel in customs matters, supply chain security, and trade facilitation.

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Economic Operator that guarantees the Customs Service a **high level of security regarding its operations and legal compliance** at both national and international levels.

Technological development in the customs IT system. **Automated and interoperable AEO module.**

Advisory Group between Customs, the Private Sector, and OGA to initiate and co-create customs initiatives, policies, and programs that help ensure consistency and common understanding, **with sufficient legal certainty.**
