

PREPERATIONS

Keeping up to date

Modifying the legislation (international standarts, case studies, experiences etc.)

Training activies (exercises etc.)

ACTIONS

Implementing measures taken

Coordinating and cooperating with relevant bodies

Ensuring smooth communication

7/24 Service

RECOVERY

Providing waiver or deferral of duties, taxes, fees and penalties

Increasing public contribution in forms of political and financial incentives



Turkish Customs in Action

3C APPROACH

Cooperation Coordination Communication

- An active participant in the Emergency Management Center under the DEMP
- 7/24 shifts at Customs

- Providing information
 (Press Release/Social media posts/Turkish representatives abroad)
- Procedures with minimum time and effort



FACILITATION OF CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

- Pre-arrival notifications & Prioritization
- Oral Declaration (Accompanied by a list of goods and a bill of lading if available)
- ATA Carnet, security and letter of undertaking (public institutions) for temporary admission
- Accelerated processing of passenger belongings and professional equipment for international relief teams


RISK ANALYSIS for RELIEF GOODS

Circular No. 2025/1 on Goods Sent/Brought in Crisis Situations


Customs procedures for crisis goods (temporary admission and entry into free circulation)
