







Total turnover of foreign trade




Common challenges facing LLDCs





For Landlocked Developing Countries, the support amounted to US\$3.6 billion – 0.5% of the combined GDP of LLDCs or roughly USD\$7.00 per capita. The increase in cases of COVID-19 has resulted in increased and urgent demand for health care, yet the health systems in some of the LLDCs are among the weakest in the world. LLDCs are also critically dependent on imported medicine, medical equipment, and pharmaceutical products.


