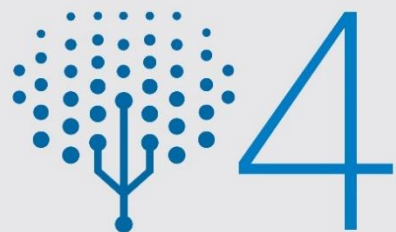

Strengthening of customs and inter-agency controls at the borders of pharmaceutical products, drugs precursors, introduction of electronic certificates for pharmaceutical goods and their efficient control in the Single Window environment.
	Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all	As Customs applies in their controls the international conventions of Basel, Rotterdam, and Stockholm water quality is expected to improve by reducing pollution, eliminating dumping and minimizing release of hazardous chemicals and materials.

	Strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the Global Partnership for Sustainable Development	The ASYCUDA customs system, by applying international standards, trade-related agreements, and through collaborating with other national authorities, countries and international agencies such as the WCO, contributes to increased efficiency and coordination, strengthened resource mobilization and trade facilitation and statistics. In addition, the ASYCUDA Programme organizes a multitude of study tours, technical and functional training sessions for customs delegations to visit and learn from experiences in implementing new technology and/or new infrastructure in other parts of the world.
