❖ Japan Customs has continuously dispatched customs experts to Malaysian Customs through JICA since 2006 and provided technical assistance primarily focused on "trade facilitation" and "risk management".

<Past Performance by Long-term dispatched experts>

2006~2008 Advancement of Customs System: Risk Management

2008~2011 Customs Risk Management in the fields of customs clearance and post clearance audit

2011~2015 Customs Policy for promotion of trade

2015~2018 Enhancing transparency and predictability regarding preferential rules of origin in EPAs
