

BACKGROUND

- The need for the implementation of a National Single Window for Ghana's trade facilitation had become apparent by 2015 owing to the numerous challenges associated with the level of paper processes which pertained at the time.
- A feasibility study conducted in 2015 by the Korea Customs Service in collaboration with GRA-Customs Division underlined this fact and a Master plan for Customs modernization was developed out of the study.
- In addition, Ghana signed and ratified the WTO TFA in 2017 and the deployment of a NSW was notified as a Category B measure.
- Subsequently Government of Ghana through the Ministry of Trade & Industry in 2018 contracted a local service provider; Ghana Link Network Services Ltd (GLNS) together with their technical partners; Customs UNIPASS International Agency (CUPIA) of South Korea to develop and implement a NSW system based on the UNIPASS technology.






Milestones





Declarant inputs common information to the Preparation Document and applies simultaneously to all agencies and declarant can view each agency's processing status all at once.






Cargo Tracking







Selectivity Feedback Mechanism






