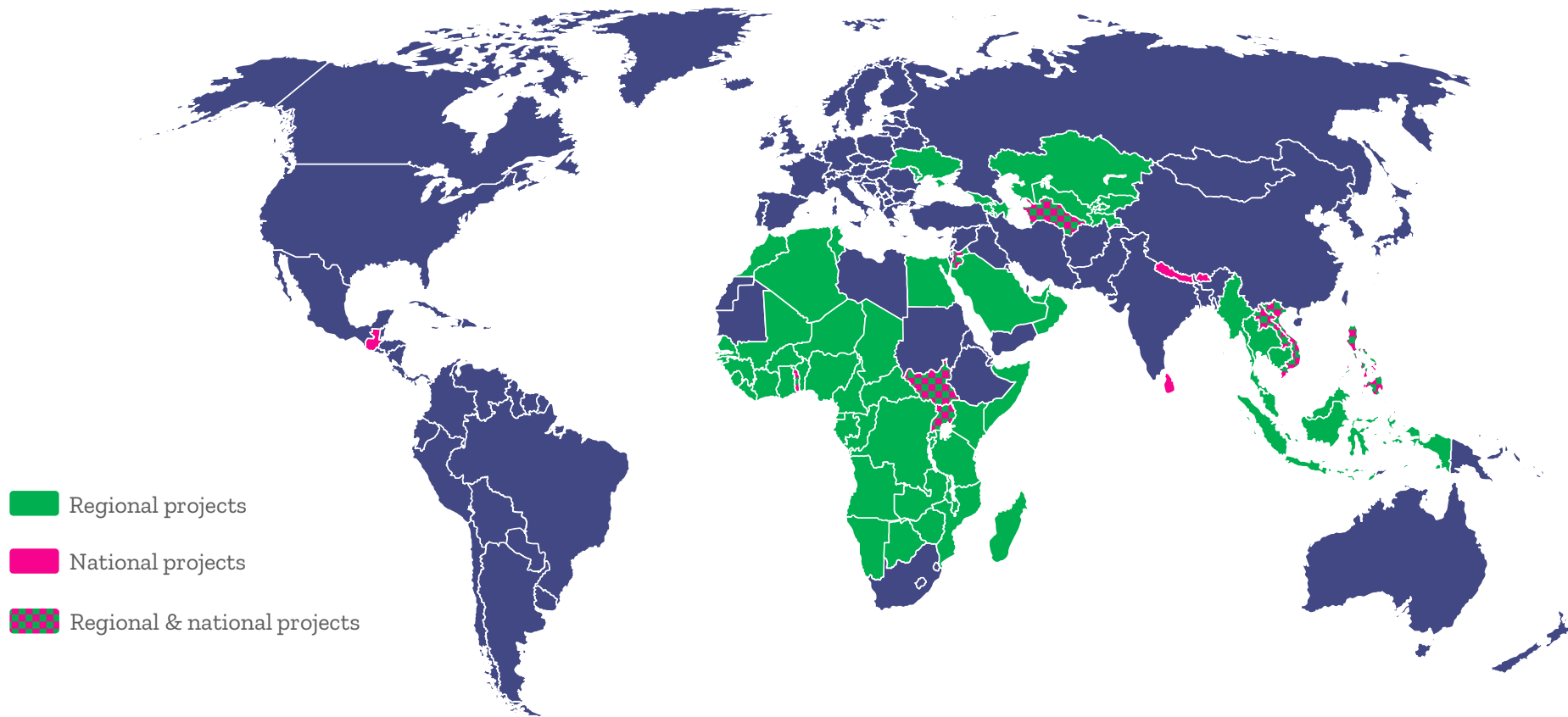

## ITC's TACB support at a glance



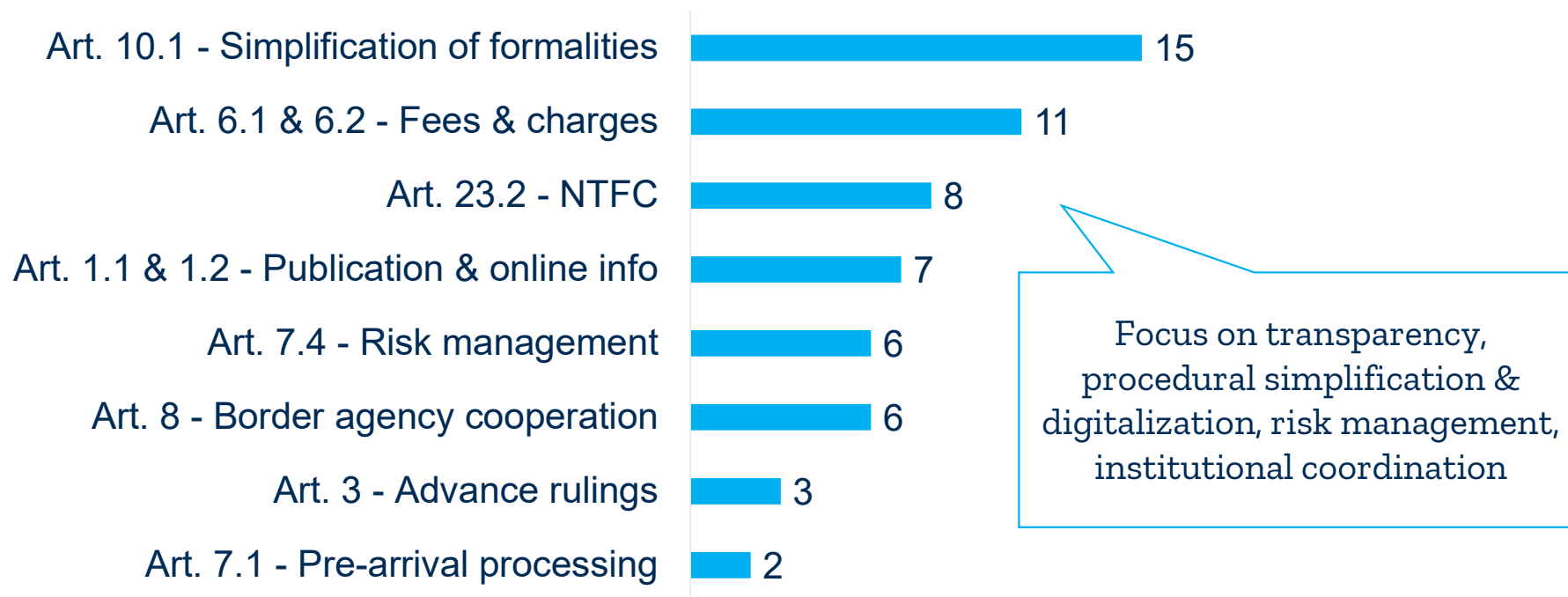
Most of ITC's support to TFA implementation is delivered through regional or corridor projects

ITC also supports the implementation of Articles **4, 7.2, 7.6, 7.7, 7.8, 10.4, 10.9 and 11** throughout various projects

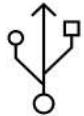
# Expanding services to align with global innovations and local needs – and maximize impact of TFA implementation

**Equipping small-scale traders with info and skills** to comply with border requirements

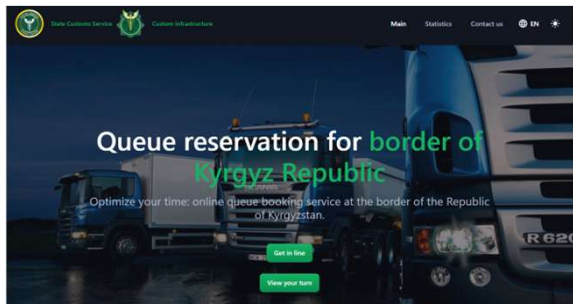

# Spotlight TACB: Deploying innovative digital solutions to streamline trade processes – eQMS

## With electronic Queue Management Systems (eQMS)

- Trucks book online a slot at border crossing
- Algorithm manages the queue and adjusts time
- Trucks arrive at the BCP just in time for processing



## First-ever eQMS in Kyrgyz Republic

- ➔ **Reduces time and cost** of border clearance
- ➔ **Prioritizes clearance** of emergency & perishable cargo
- ➔ **Reduces goods spoilage** due to improved planning of transport and customs operations
- ➔ **Reduces CO2** emissions at the border
- ➔ **Improves cooperation** between border agencies

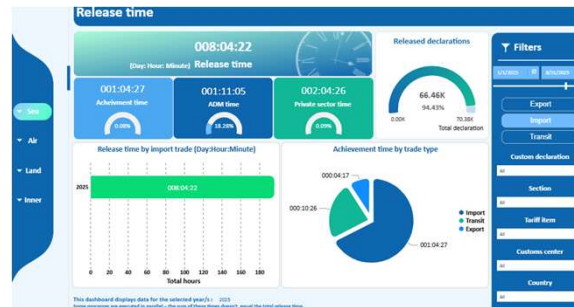
# Spotlight TACB: Deploying innovative digital solutions to streamline trade processes – Trade & Logistics Gateway

## Trade and Logistics Performance Gateway

- Detect earlier anomalies across sea, air, and land operations
- Accelerate evidence-based reform implementation
- Improve predictability and transparency for traders and logistics operators



Modules of the Jordan Trade and Logistics Performance Gateway

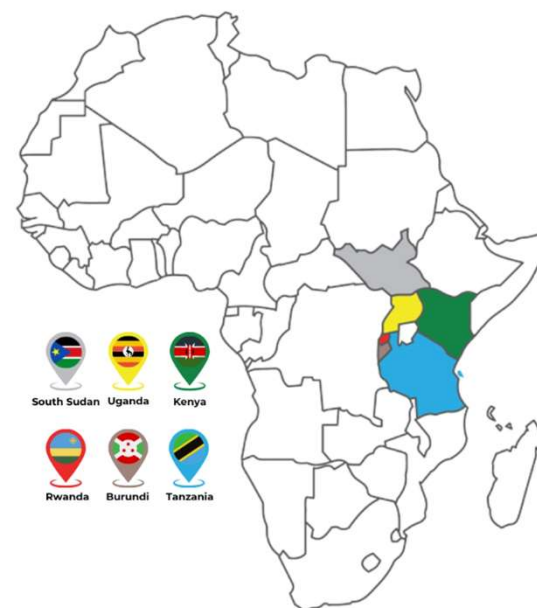


## First-ever Gateway in Jordan

- ➔ **40+ public and private entities** connected
- ➔ **1+ TB of trade data** analyzed
- ➔ **1+ billion records** processed
- ➔ **1500+ real-time KPIs** monitored
- ➔ **450 interactive dashboards** developed
- ➔ **27 modules** deployed
- ➔ **5 years** of historical data

# Spotlight TACB: Fostering intra-regional trade integration – MARKUP programme

- ➔ **Enhancement of national Trade Facilitation Portals** and establishment of a new portal in South Sudan
- ➔ **Strengthening of the regional EAC Trade Information Portal**, including the introduction of a corridor-view of cross-border formalities
- ➔ **Value-chain approach to simplification and digitalization of border procedures** to improve predictability and reduce documentary burdens
- ➔ **Capacity building for non-customs border agencies to strengthen risk management** and coordinated border controls
- ➔ **Promotion of regional peer learning and experience-sharing** on managing Trade Facilitation Portals and advancing procedural simplification



# Spotlight TACB: Fostering intra-regional trade integration – ASEAN SCOPE project

- ➔ **Support to development of strategic regional trade facilitation frameworks**, including the ASEAN Trade Facilitation Strategic Action Plan 2026–2030
- ➔ **Stocktaking of low-value shipment practices at national level** as a basis for prospective regional harmonization
- ➔ **Enhancement of business awareness and utilization of the ASEAN-Wide Self-Certification mechanism** for smoother origin certification
- ➔ **Support to customs transit harmonization** and multimodal expansion of the ASEAN Customs Transit System (ACTS)
- ➔ **Strengthening of green customs practices** to improve environmental compliance at borders and promote trade in circular economy goods





We remained guided by the principle that **TFA implementation is a collective effort** premised on coordination and collaboration
