



UNCTAD has regularly published NTFC studies





Digitalization & Single Window

NTFCs' role in implementing transparency measures, like trade portals, rose from 38% in 2013 to 50% in 2024.

A single window trade system using ASYCUDA is now live in Turkmenistan, and a technical project started with Saint Vincent and the Grenadines joining 13 other countries already working on or using ASYSW. UNCTAD's roadmap guides countries in building custom ASYSW systems using existing ASYCUDA setups and real-world case studies.





NTFCs met 1-5 times during the year. Meeting frequency increased slightly in 2024, with 82% of NTFCs convening at least once, up from 76% in 2023.

NTFCs reported sharing trade facilitation information, but only 46% communicated about their own work



Increase need for technical support to improve communication, with 63% citing it as critical to performance—up from 58% in 2023.

New intensive training on communication for NTFCs to be piloted in 2025

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

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Mobilizing Resources for Trade Facilitation NTFCs did engage in resource mobilization.



71% expressed a growing need to boost resource mobilization, up from 62% the previous year.

To support this, UNCTAD delivered a resource mobilization course in French and English, completed by over 100 NTFC stakeholders. The course will continue annually.







Enhancing regional and international cooperation

National Trade Facilitation Committees play a crucial role in supporting regional integration across various countries. However, engagement in this area appears to have decreased in 2024 compared to 2023.

- 28% negotiated or promoted trade facilitation agreements (down from 36%),
- 47% advised or promoted the implementation of international or regional trade facilitation obligations and standards (down from 51%),
- and 61% participated in meetings and/or experiencesharing with other NTFCs at the regional and/or international level (down from 67%).








