The information is published in a non-discriminatory manner. A trade information portal is currently being set up under the regional EU-EAC-MARKUP project financed by the European Union. The ITC is responsible for its implementation.

- Establishment of a single office responsible for collecting, centralizing and disseminating trade-related information
- Training of staff from the above-mentioned office on information and communication

This provision is partially implemented by the Burundi Bureau of Standards and Quality Control (BBN). BBN laboratories have recently been provided with high-quality infrastructure through the regional MARKUP project financed by the EU. However, it remains insufficient.

A draft national quality policy law is currently being prepared and is pending adoption by the Government.

Technical assistance and capacity building support needs include:

- Establishment of a legal framework for test procedures
- Provision of sufficient equipment for the laboratories of the BBN, the Ministry of Agriculture, and transit centres
- Creation of a system for the management of all laboratories responsible for tests
